

Articles of agreement made, and entered into the ninth day of March A. D. 1836. Between William Johnston of Armstrong township & county of Indiana, of the one part, and David Anthony of the same place Witnesseth, That whereas the deputy Surveyor Robert Magee in laying a warrant on lands for the said William Johnston in January last past, interfered, and ran over on the claim of David Anthony about fifteen acres, which warrant (with the interference marked) has been returned to the Land office, Now this article witnesseth that he the said William Johnston doth hereby relinquish, and forever quit claim to the said interference of fifteen acres, and doth allow that the warrant to the said David Anthony shall be laid, and take in the said fifteen acres, or in other words, to a division line between the said parties, marked and run by Alexander Taylor in 1807. And further he doth hereby empower, and request the officers of the Land office, or any of them to mark the lines, on the return of his warrant, agreeably to these articles, and to issue his Patent for the remainder, - And whereas David Anthony party of the second part did enter a caveat at the Land office against the above mentioned survey made to William Johnston, now he the said David Anthony doth hereby agree that upon the above mentioned articles on the part of the said William Johnston being complied with, and done by him or the officers of the Land office for him, forever to withdraw his said caveat and allow a patent to issue to the said William Johnston as mentioned on the part of first party, and as tho' no such caveat had ever been entered, - In testimony whereof the parties hereunto have set their hand and seals the day and year first above written.
