



The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 14<sup>th</sup> day 1794 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Joseph Ashton for 400 acres of land Dated the tenth day of February 1794 adjoining Oliver Ormsbey to the Eastward and on the North Side of Conaguenessing North and West of the River Ohio Called Sparton Containing four Hundred and thirty six acres three Quarters and twenty five poles together with the usual allowance of Six per cent for Roads
