



Situate in Franklin township Fayette County on the waters of Redstone Creek Surveyed on the 30th day of December A. D. 1840 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Jonathan Addis for 93 acres dated the 3rd day of June A. D. 1839. It may have been improved 60 years ago. Has on it 2 small dwelling houses, and a couple of families residing. Nearly all the land improved say 70 at least.
