



Situate on the waters of Sidelinghill Creek in Dublin (now Broad top) township Bedford county containing within the black lines 230 acres 34 perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Originally surveyed on three several warrants as follows Viz No. 1 containing 26 acres and allowance &c. surveyed on warrant granted to Alexander Alexander dated the 10th January 1793. No. 2 containing 76 1/4 acres and allowance &c. surveyed on warrant granted to Joseph Edwards bearing date the 7th February 1774. No. 3 Part of a larger tract of land containing 127 acres 153 perches & allowance &c. (The whole of the Original contains 230 acres &c.) surveyed on warrant granted to Hercules Kemp and James Burd dated the 2d February 1776. Resurveyed according to the old marks upon the ground for George Chessnut and Joshua Edwards Executors of Joseph Edwards Deceased the 15th April 1794
