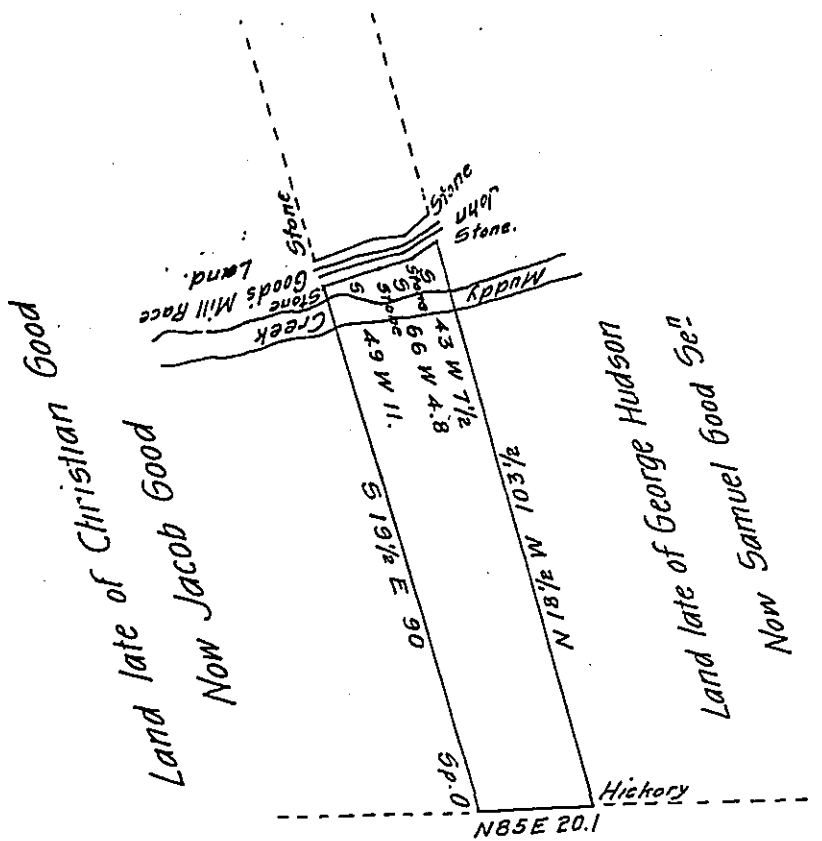

Resurveyed according to the old lines & corners of a Survey formerly made by Sam^l Lightfoot for the said George Hudson. By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 29th day of September A. D. 1738 &c.^a
