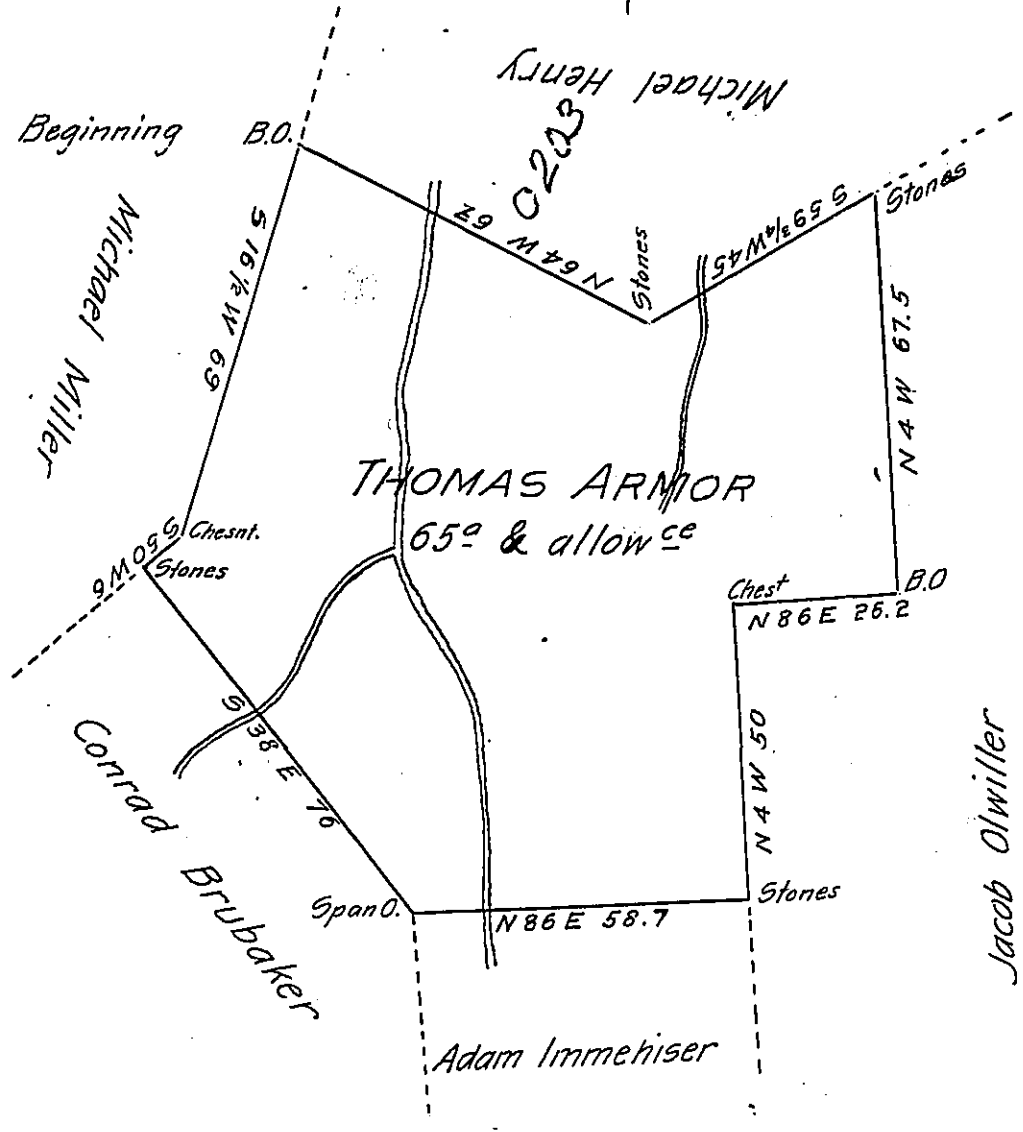

Situate in Windsor (formerly York) Township York County, Containing as above set forth 65 acres and allowance. Being part of a larger tract of land originally surveyed on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of February 1755 by George Stevenson late D.S. in pursuance of a Warrant bearing date the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April 1754 granted to Thomas Armor. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 18<sup>th</sup> of 7<sup>th</sup> Mo. 1794. by William Kersey late D.S. And now, after having been carefully examined, corrected and calculated, it is, at the request of the present owner, Peter Mengus, returned for confirmation the 29<sup>th</sup> day of July A.D. 1809.
