



Situate in Windsor Township in the County of York. A. Containing as above set forth 17^{as} 127 perches and allowance, represents part of a larger tract of 221^{as} & allow^{ce} which was originally surveyed by William Kersey late D.S. on the 18^h of the 10th month 1788 for Ulrich Elleberger. In pursuance of two Warrants granted to Michael Atkinson one dated the 23^d day of February 1749, the other the 29th of June 1757. B. Containing 31^{as} & 21 perches and allowance represents part of a larger tract of 57^{as} & 103 P^s & allowance which was originally surveyed on the 10th of the 12th Mo. 1766 by William Mathews late D.S. for Richard Stroman. In pursuance of a Warrant for 25^{as} dated the 26^h day of February 1759. Resurveyed and divided off from the said two larger tracts of land the 7th day of August Anno Domini 1809. for Adam Shenberger the present owner: who desired me to make Return of the Draught as above for Confirmation
