In Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Elias Alexander bearing date the 1st of April 1751 and now resurveyed & divided off from the said Larger Tract of Land on the 13th day of December 1810 In pursuance of an Order from the Honorable Board of Property dated the 6th day of December 1809 for Thomas & James Buchanan the present owners who desired the same to be Returned for Confirmation
