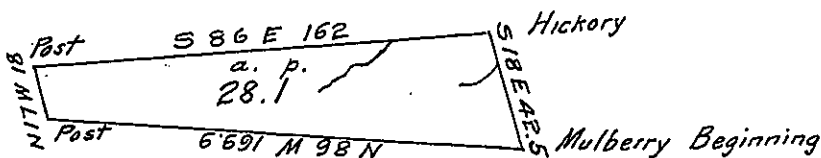

 and Joshua Allen for 28 acres of Land, dated the 23^d

 ington County called Remnant, Containing twenty
 eight acres & one perch together with the usual
 allowance of six per cent for Roads
