



The above draft represents a Tract of land situate in Sadsbury Township Chester County containing 53<sup>as</sup> 80<sup>ps</sup> & allowance of six Per Cent for roads &c. Being part of a Tract of 178<sup>as</sup> & allowance which was surveyed on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of December 1781 unto William Armstrong on his Warrant dated the 31<sup>st</sup> day of January 1750 and which has been divided and laid off to Francis Armstrong son of the said William Armstrong who is now deceased.
