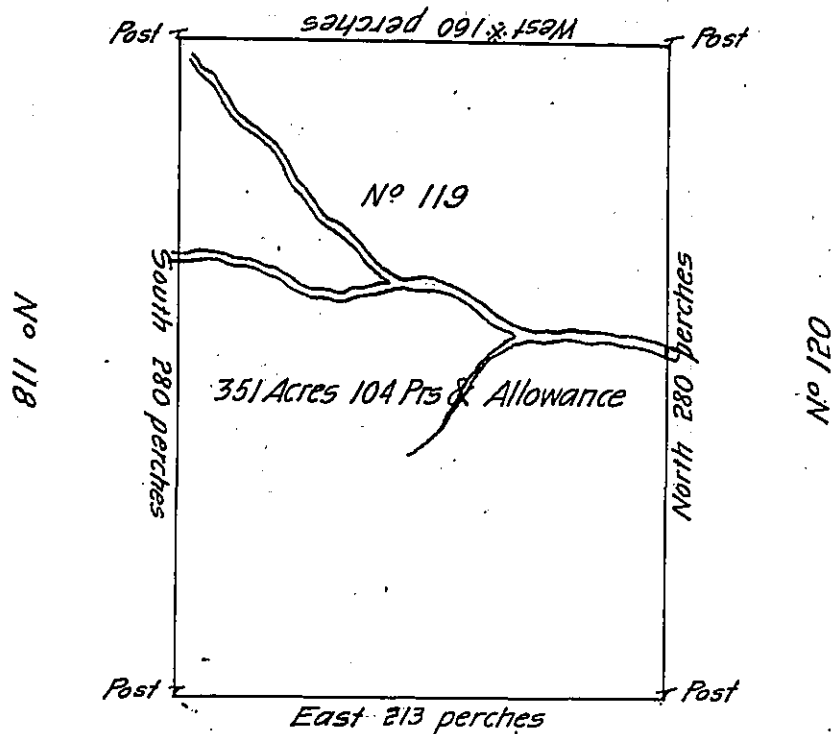

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania to me directed bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783 the above tract of land Containing three hundred and fifty one Acres and one hundred and four perches & allowance of Six Pr. Cent for roads &c<sup>o</sup> was surveyed on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785 by
