



In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783  
 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Comission under  
 the hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State  
 of Pennsylvania to me directed bearing date at Philadelphia the 14<sup>th</sup> day of  
 August 1783 the above tract of land containing three hundred and fifty three  
 acres and thirty eight perches & allowance of Six Pr. Cent for roads &c<sup>a</sup>  
 was surveyed on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785 by
