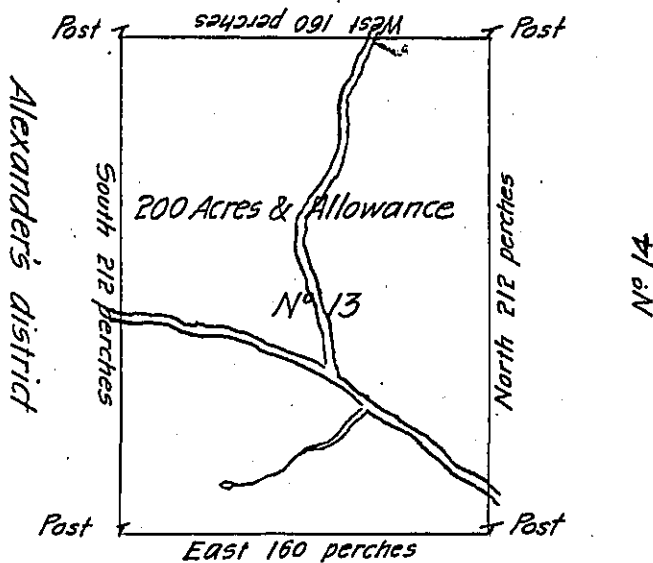

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed on the 12<sup>th</sup> of March 1783 ~~and by~~ for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission to me directed under the hand and seal of office of John Lukens Esquire Surveyor General for the State of Pensylvania bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1783 the above tract of land containing two hundred acres and allowance of 6 Pr. Cent for roads &c.<sup>a</sup> was surveyed on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of June 1785 by
