



Situate on Sandy Creek, in Wharton Township, Fayette County and surveyed the 11th day of November 1854, in pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Francis Rose for 400 Acres, dated the 5th day of February 1794. — there is three cabin-houses, near 50 acres cleared and a family residing on this tract the first improvement is more than 40 years old.
