



Situate on Dandy Creek and on the line between Pennsylvania and Virginia in Wharton Township, Fayette County and surveyed the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November 1854 in pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Hayden Rose for 400 acres of Land dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of February 1794. There is about 50 acres cleared on this tract, a log house and Barn & has been improved about 40 years.
