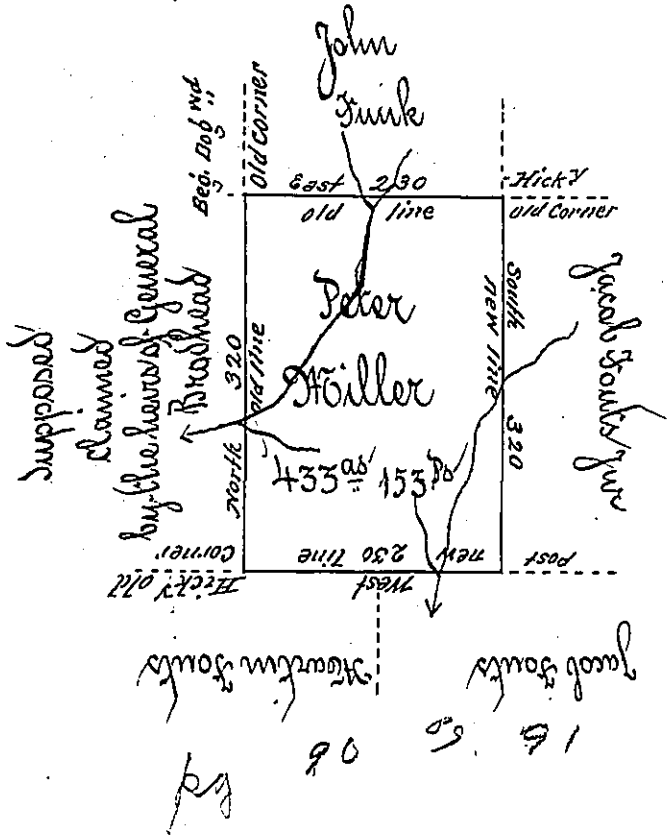

In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Peter Hoeller dated 16<sup>th</sup> January 1793
