Report. The above Tract together with the red lined figure marked B is covered by a Survey of 143 As. 102^{rs} made the 28 April 1798 on a Warrant to William Brotherton dated 25 February 1794.

The above Tract is held by Hugh Brotherton under the title founded on the Warrant to Wm Brotherton - Michael Kelly tenant on the land. W. Brotherton - not patd W.S.D.
