



The above is a Draft of a Tract of Land which was surveyed to Alexander Brisson on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of May 1804 by virtue of his Warrant dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of January 1804 containing four Hundred and one Acres & 75 perches and Allowance of Six per Cent &c including his actual settlement and improvement situate in Consequenessing Township Butler County.
