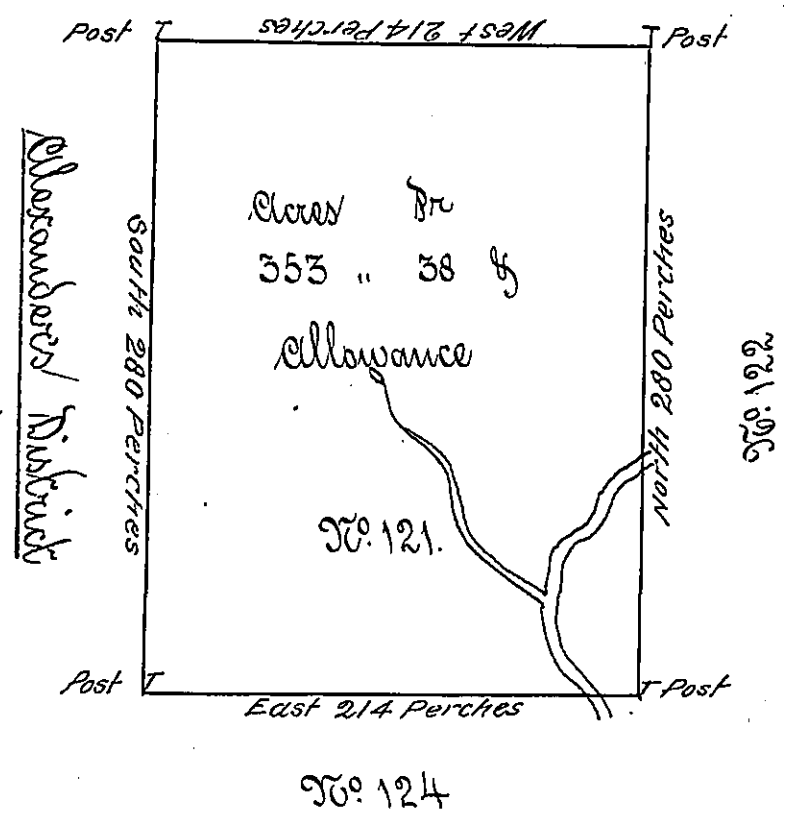

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12 day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and seal of Office of John Lukens Esq. Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania - to me directed bearing date at ~~Philadelphia~~ ^{Penn.} 18th of July 1783 the above tract of land containing three hundred and fifty three acres and thirty eight perches & allowance of six p^{er} cent for roads &c. was surveyed on the 8th day of July 1785 by
