



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3d day of July 1772 on a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Twenty Three containing in Breadth East and West on Shamokin Street Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Southward by Shamokin Street aforesaid, Eastward by Lot Number forty Eight, Northward by Mulberry Alley, and Westward part by Lot number twenty two, and part by the Center Square. Returned into the Secretary's office the 13th day of September 1774 for Thomond Ball by Warrant dated the same day.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this third day of November 1903
