 The above Deft is a copy as near as may be of a right Deft found among the Field Works of John & Jacob Saull decd and which I believe to be in the hand writing of one Mordicai Yarnall. I have not examined how correct it ^{is} maybe as I conceived you only want to know the time it was Surveyed. I Directed the Deace to acquaint you how long the Land had been Surveyed & told him he must pay the Quitrent & Interest from that time but it seems he did not chose to do it. - I should be glad if you would on such occasions favour me with a line because I cannot tell how far to credit same.
