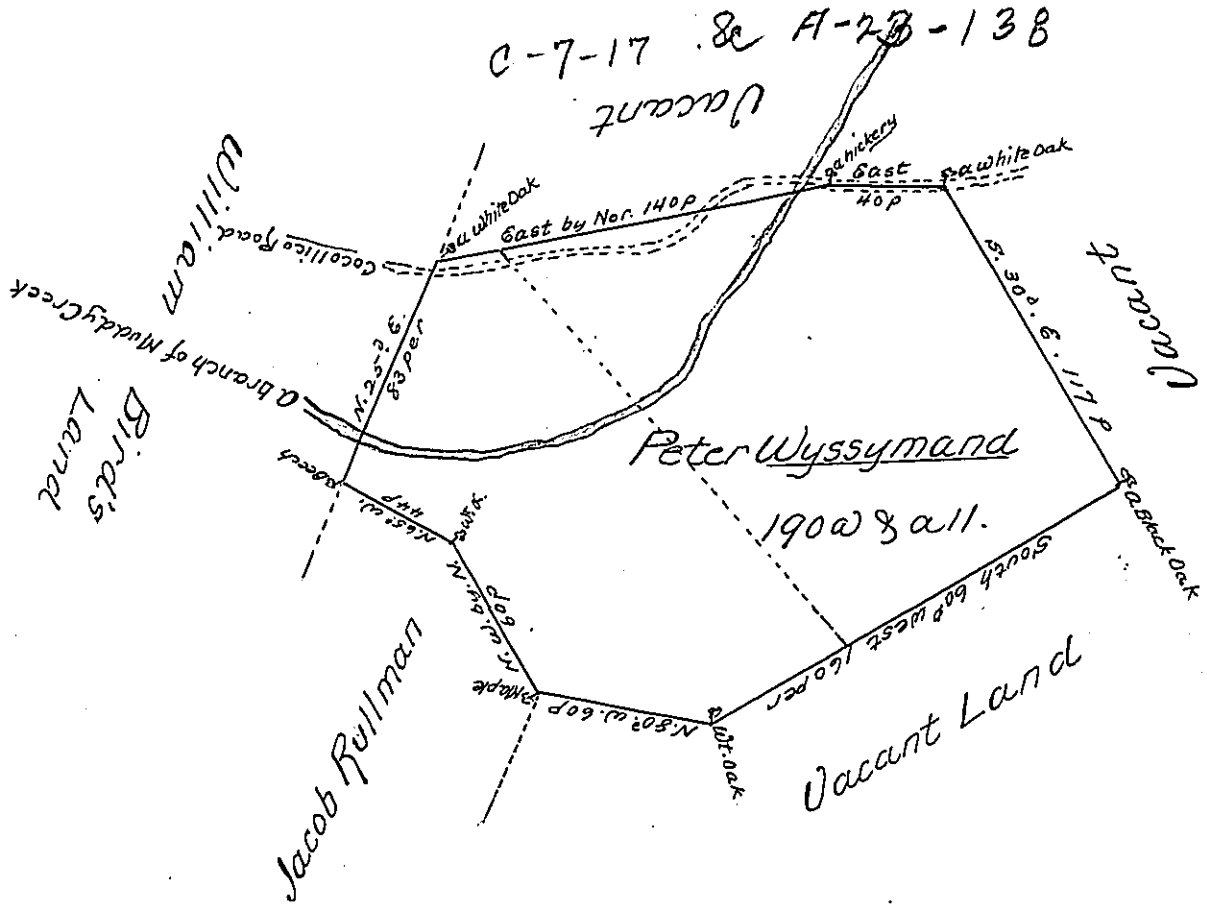

Containing One Hundred and Ninety acres beside the allowance of Six pcent.
