



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Bowling Green situate on the Head Waters of a Run which empties into the West side of Stony Creek about four miles above Conemaugh old Town (which Run is now called Ben's Creek) about seven miles North from Kickeny-pawling's old Town adjoining Lands of Henry Landis and Martin Kreider in Brother's Valley, & in Turkey-foot Township in ¹⁵⁰⁰ County of Bedford containing three hundred and twenty Acres and the usual Allowance of six pcent for Roads &c.
