



A Draught of an Island Situate in the river Susquehanna called Jacobs Island opposite to lands of Stephen Thonus Cooper in York County and Nicholas Boyd in Lancaster County being the most Easterly of the two Islands called Jacobs Islands and the nearest to the Lancaster Shore Situate in Little Britain Township Lancaster County containing thirty five perches Strict Measure Surveyed the 21<sup>st</sup> of September 1814, and by warrant dated the 28<sup>th</sup> of October 1814 granted unto Samuel Boyd Esqr.
