



A Draught of a Lot of Ground in the Town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland marked in (661) General Plan of said Town Number Thirteen Situate on the North side of High Street Containing in Breadth East and West Sixty feet and in Length North and South two hundred and forty feet Bounded Southward by High Street aforesaid, Westward by Lot Number five, Northward by a twenty feet Alley, and Eastward by Lot Number Twenty one. Returned into the Secretary's office the 3^d day of March 1774 for William Bell Merchant of Market Street in the City of Philad^a by Warrant dated the 2^d of March 1774.
