Situate in Mannheim Township in the County of York containing as above set forth 74as & 37 Perches and Allowance Being part of a larger Tract of Land, which was Originally Surveyed on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1766 by Archibald McClean late U.S. In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Johan Potterfield alias John Bottafield bearing date the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April Anno Domini\* 1765 And now on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May A.D. 1809. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land, at the instance and request of the present owner Jacob Blocher who desired me to make Return of the Draught -
