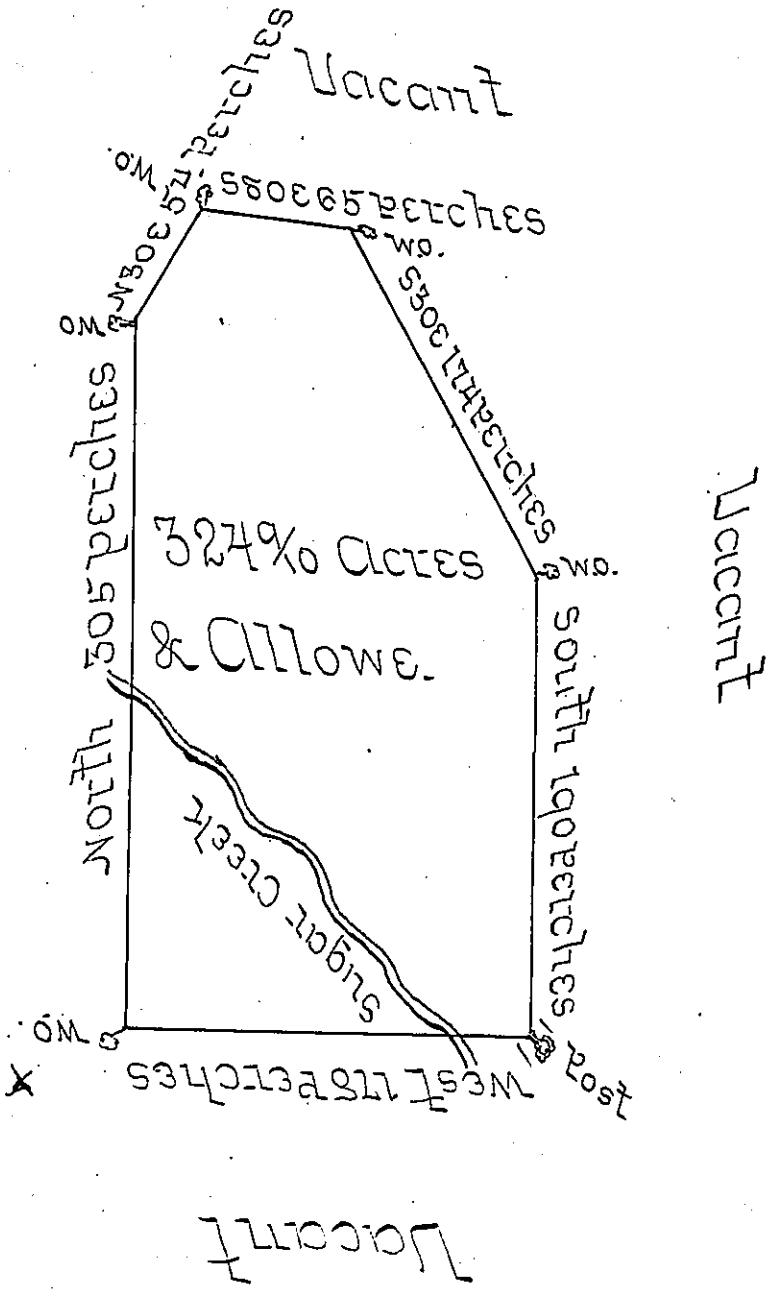


Chas. Biddle & Isaac Meason Esquires
