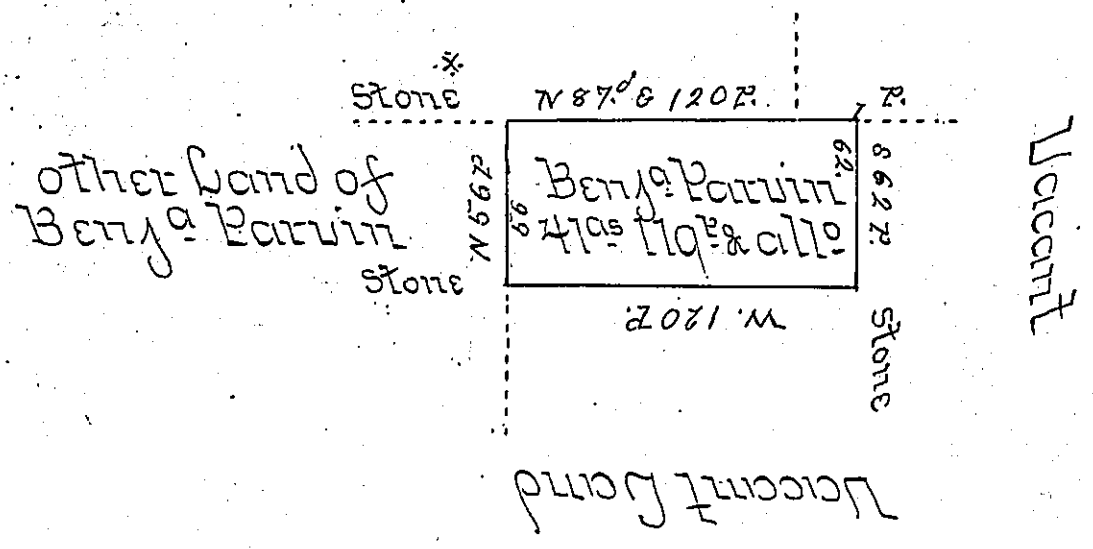

Cent.
