 ing date the 22<sup>d</sup> day of April Anno Domini 1818.

N.B. The improvements on the above described tract at the  
 time of surveying the same, consisted of a log dwelling  
 House with a family living in it; and about three acres  
 of cleared land rendering it an actual personal resident  
 Settlement with a manifest intention of making it a  
 place of abode and means of supporting a family.
