



Situate on the waters of Brush Creek (formerly in Londonderry Township Bedford Coty) now Allegani Towns-hip Somerset County and surveyed the 13<sup>th</sup> day of September 1809 in pursuance of a land Office Receipt for a Warrant of 250<sup>a</sup> dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of January 1793. Granted to Jacob Buss which Warrant was Executed by my predecessor, on this Ground. but s<sup>d</sup> Warrant together with the original Draught cannot be found being mislaid, or perhaps remains in the Deputy Surveyors office, at Bedford
