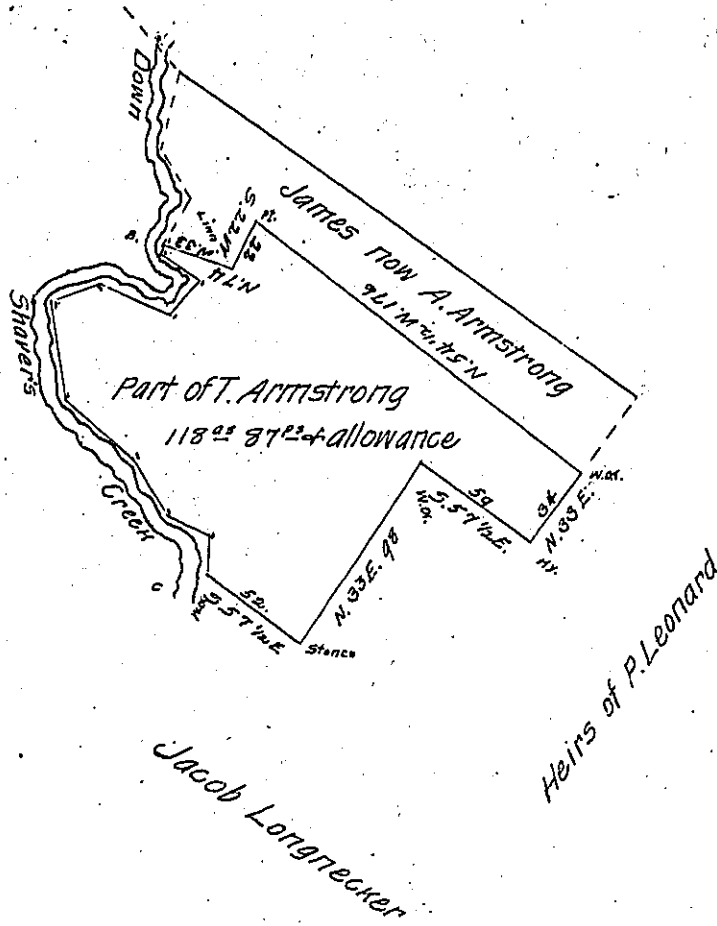

then Said to Contain 169 Acres & allowance. This part Resurveyed
& Divided from the Residue of Said tract the 15th day of February
1832.
