 hundred and twenty three acres one hundred and thirty  
 two perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c  
 Situate in the Township of Unity and County of West-  
 moreland the whole of said tract of land was surveyed  
 on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August 1791. By John Moore Esq then  
 Deputy surveyor In pursuance of a warrant dated April  
 24<sup>th</sup> 1786 granted to Ephraim Blain containing three hun-  
 dred and fifty nine acres thirty four perches and allow-  
 ance.
