We the Commissioners, appointed for settling the Claims to unpatented land in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania, and Ohio do hereby Certify that Otho Brashiers Assignee of William Colvin is intitled to four hundred Acres of land in the Counties of Monongalia, & Yohogania on the waters of Dunlap's Creek to include his Settlement made in the year of our Lord, one Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Given under our hands, at Redstone, old fort the Sixteenth Day of December 1779, in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
