We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to Unpatented Lands in the the Counties of Monongalia & Ohio do hereby Certify that Barney Bonner is Entitled to four hundred Acres of Land in the County of Ohio on Buffalo Creek to include his Actual Settlement made in the Year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred, and Seventy Seven, and also a Right in preemption to one thousand Acres adjoining thereto Given Under our hands at Cox fort the twenty second day of February 1780 in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth
