In Pursuance of an Act of Assembly Passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of Certain Lands therein mentioned, and by Virtue of a Commission Under the Hand, and seal of Office from John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783 the above tract of Land containing two hundred, and Sixteen Acres, and one hundred, and fifty Six Perches, and Allowance of 6 P<sup>er</sup> Cent for Roads &c. Was surveyed, on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785 by
