 of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia  
 the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783 The Above tract of  
 land Containing two hundred, and sixteen Acres  
 and 156 Perches, and Allowance, of 6 P Cent for  
 Roads &c. Was surveyed on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of
