



Situate on a small stream which falls into the Youghiogheny River on the southwest side and opposite the old Saltworks in Henry Clay township Fayette County & Surveyed the 27th day of June 1832 In pursuance of a Warrant in the Name of Samuel Baker for 200^{ac} dated the 28th day of June 1786.

There has been 10 or 12 acres cleared and cultivated and a Cabin erected on this land which was occasionally occupied for several years but no family on it for several years past first improvement must have been made 30 to 40 years ago.
