



A Draught of A Tract of Land, called the Yellow Spring Tract, situated on the Path leading from Bedford to Frankstown about half a Mile below the three Springs including the Yellow Spring adjoining and Westward of Morrison's Cove Mountain Northerly of Thomas Cook & Southerly of Timothy Smith in Frankstown Township in the County of Bedford Containing three hundred and seventeen Acres & the usual Allowance of six <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Cent. for Roads &c Surveyed the third & fourth Days of April 1775 for Arthur St. Clair in Pursuance of an Order No. 4597 Dated the 23<sup>d</sup> Day of November 1767.
