



In pursuance of a warrant for 400 acres dated the 15th day of July A.D. 1816, granted to Isaac Bloomfield, was surveyed on the 13th day of June A.D. 1817. The above described tract of land containing 390 acres 91 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads, &c. situated in Bloomfield township, Crawford county, and at the time of making the same, Isaac Bloomfield was residing thereon, and there was built a house fit for the habitation of man, and there appeared to be upwards of 15- acres of the land, cleared, fenced and in a state of cultivation, and that the same was divided as above stated, between, said Bloomfield & Joseph Clark
