



Situate in Warriormark Township Huntingdon County first surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Baynton & Samuel Wharton dated the 28th July 1766. It then was said to contain Five hundred and ninety two acres & the usual allowance. This part contains two hundred and seventy two acres 149 perches and the usual allowance and was resurveyed and divided from the residue of said tract the 9th day of May 1822
