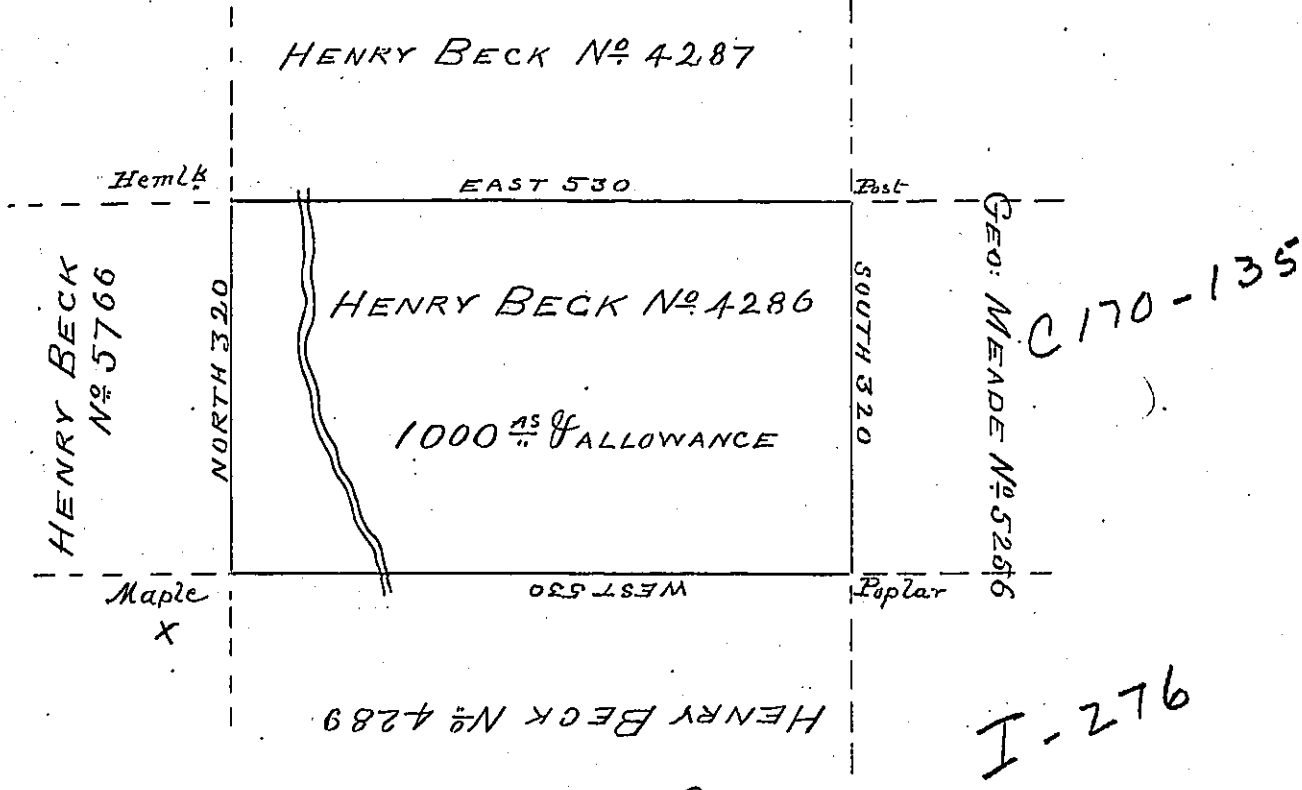

Containing One thousand acres and the usual allowance of six Per Cent for roads &c. Surveyed & surveyed the 11th Day of September 1798, by James Hunter Esq: late Pa. Deputy Surveyor, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Henry Beck No. 4286, dated the 9th Day of December 1793.
