



Situate in St. Clair township Bedford County containing 41 acres 95 perches & allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Surveyed by Samuel Ake Esq for Anthony Bowser the first of December 1751. Being a part of a tract that originally contained 230 acres and allowance. Surveyed in pursuance of an order No 697 dated the 2nd of August 1766, granted in the name of Sylvester Tyges, Examined, copied, and returned the 6th of December 1851. (to be patented to Anthony Bowser)
