



Situate on the waters of Redstone Creek in Union Township Fayette County Surveyed on the 23rd day of June 1845 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Frederick Byrer of Union Borough for 140 acres of land dated on the 13th day of June A.D. 1845 on this tract there is about 70 or 80 acres of Cleared Land two dwelling houses and small Barn has been improved 40 or 50 years.
