



The above is the Draught of a survey made February 11th 1829 for John Boyd in pursuance of a warrant dated 23rd January 1829 granted to him for twenty five acres of land being improved adjoining lands of said John Boyd on the South and East, and the heirs of Thomas Moore De^{ed} on the North, situated in the Township of Hemmer in the County of Beaver, Containing thirty seven acres three quarters thirty one perches and allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c.
