



Draft of a part of a Tract of land situated in Southampton Township Franklin
County (formerly Lurgan Township, Cumberland County) containing one hundred &
ninety-five acres one hundred & seventeen perches. A tax assessment of six per cent for
Roads etc. Being part of a larger tract of 3000^{as} of all, which was surveyed in
pursuance of an order of survey granted to Christian Merkle dated the 23^d of
June 1769. No. 5529. Surveyed and laid off the above part for the Bank of
Chambersburg the 17th of June 1829.
