



The above is a Draught of a Survey made Sept. 4th 1826, in pursuance of a warrant granted to James Barr for two acres of Land dated August 28th 1826, but contains four acres and twenty seven perches and allowance of six for Oak for highways, situate on the waters of Ten mile Creek, in East Bethlehem Township W, County. There ^{is} about one acre of clear ground on the above, improved for about twenty ^{years} there had formerly been a house on it but is now gone
