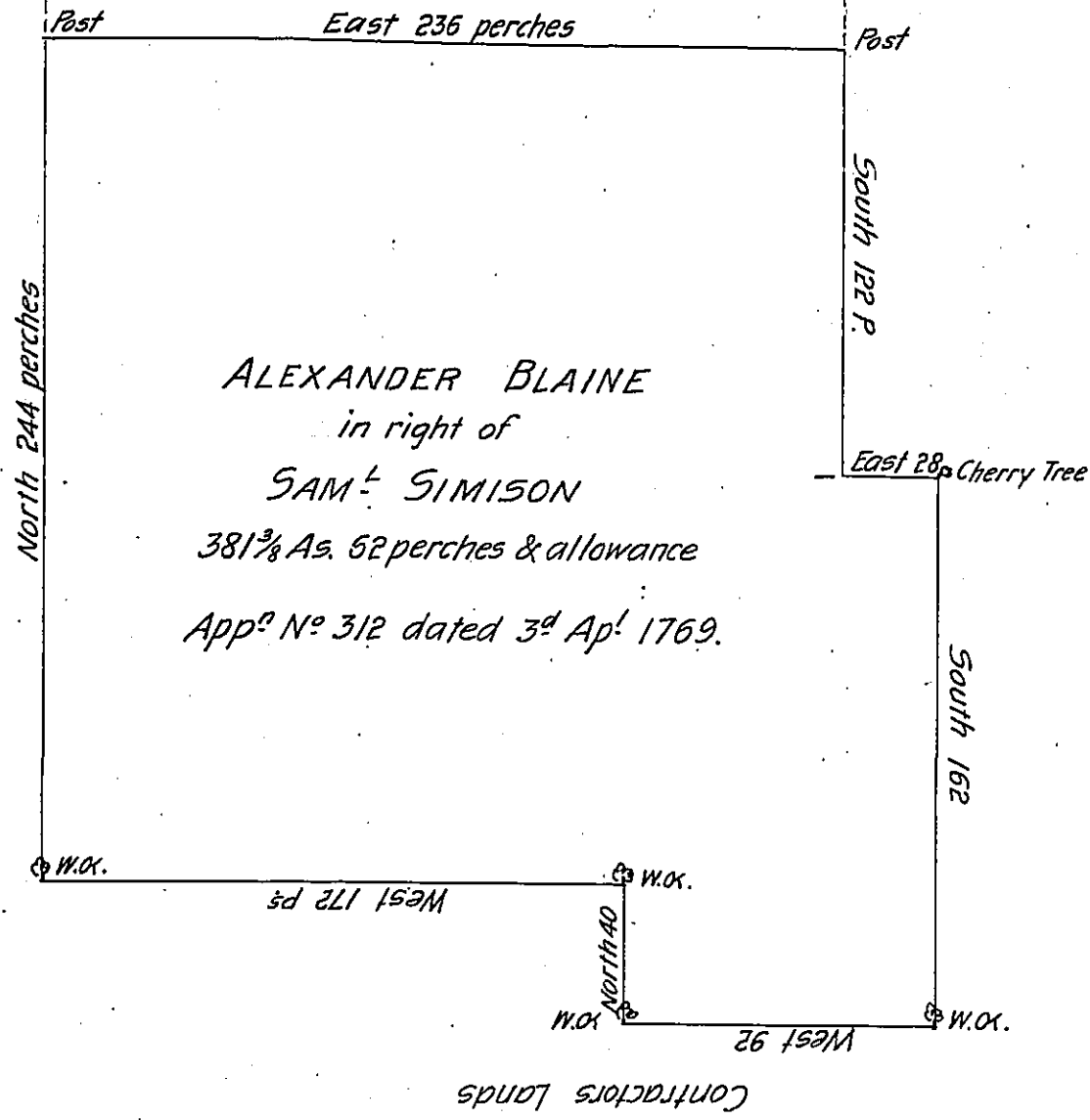

It appears by General William Thompsons drafts that in pursuance of an Order of Survey dated the 3^d day of April 1769 there was surveyed the 7th June 1769 the above described Tract of Land Containing three hundred & Eighty One Acres & Sixty two perches & Allowance situate on the Waters of Sewickly Creek in Cumberland (now Westmoreland County for Alexander Blaine Certified at Carlisle 2^d March 1787.
