Surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> September 1794 to James Boyd the above described tract of Land Situate about half mile North of Shoholy and about three Miles from Delaware River in the County of Northampton Containing three hundred and ninety one acres fifty four perches and the Allowance of Six p Cent & C<sup>a</sup>.
