

The above is a Draught of a Survey made August 7<sup>th</sup> 1838  
 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Isaac W. Byers for 20 Acres.  
 Dated Jan'y 2<sup>d</sup> 1838. Containing two Acres & 136 perches & Allowance  
 of six percent. situate in Jefferson Township, Allegheny County on the  
 waters of Peters Creek. Note, John Sheplar claims this  
 land up to Estep's line, and his Deed from Kirkendall takes it in,  
 but Kirkendall's old survey leaves it out, and runs from the W.O.  
 Stump (which is admited) as above. ~
