



Returned by the owner July 15, 1817

A Draught of a survey executed April 30th 1817 on a Warrant granted to Andrew Boggs dated March 19th 1816 for 200 acres situate in Keokan Township Allegheny County

Note... at the time of surveying the above Andrew Boggs resided thereon with his family and had 5 or 6 acres cleared and in a state of cultivation the date of the improvement appears to be in the year 1799 or 1800.

I Certify the above to be a true copy of an entry of a survey ^{in the} Book kept by David Coan a former Deputy Surveyor, and that I have examined the survey and find it to be correct and to contain two hundred and seventy four acres and seventy one perches & allow.
